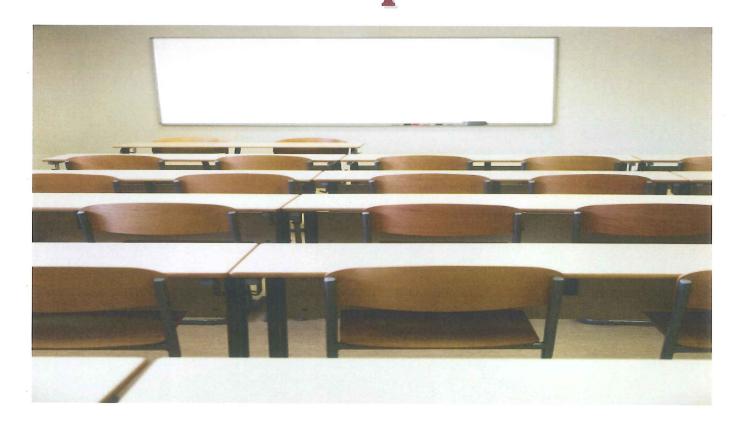

Each department will spend two days in curriculum work this summer. The potential work of each department may look as follows:

English

- English I—realigning units of instruction and CA to the CC ELA standards and designing a plan to incorporate ACT or PLAN like formative assessment questions into daily instruction and CA. The focus here is to move all students to meet CC readiness benchmarks in English and Reading. Training on CIITS.
- English II—using the MC results of the EOC, realign units of instruction and CA to EOC standards and CC ELA standards.
 Incorporating ACT or PLAN-like formative assessment questions into daily instruction. Training on CIITS.
- o English III— realigning units of instruction and CA to the CC ELA standards and designing a plan to incorporate ACT like formative assessment questions into daily instruction and CA. The focus here is to move all students to meet CC readiness benchmarks in English and Reading. Training on CIITS.
- o English IV-- realigning units of instruction and CA to the CC ELA standards and designing a plan to incorporate ACT -like formative assessment questions into daily instruction and CA. The focus here is to move all students to meet CC readiness benchmarks in English and Reading. Analysis of data to design Senior Transition course. Training on CIITS.

Science

O IPS I—realign units of instruction and CA based on the results of analysis of CA from last school year. Design CA and formative assessment items that are PLAN-like and/or ACT-like, and devise a PLAN to incorporate these items and track student progress toward readiness benchmarks throughout the school year. Finally, refine the plan for the research project based on student results And teacher feedback from last school year.

- Biology using the MC results of the EOC, realign units of instruction and CA to EOC standards. In addition, refine a plan for the research project based on student results and teacher feedback from last school year.
- Chemistry design the initial CA for the upcoming school year.
 Also, refine and incorporate a research project into the curriculum for this new course.

* Social Studies

- World Civilization realign units of instruction and CA based on the results of analysis of CA from last school year. Design CA and formative assessment items that are PLAN-like and/or ACT-like, and devise a plan to incorporate these items and track student progress toward readiness benchmark in reading throughout the school year. Finally, refine the plan for the research paper based on student results and teacher feedback from last school year.
- American Studies realign units of instruction and CA based on the results and analysis of CA from last school year. Design CA and formative assessment items that are PLAN-like and/or ACTlike, and devise a plan to incorporate these items and track student progress toward readiness benchmark in reading throughout the school year. Finally, refine the plan for the research paper based on student results and teacher feedback from last school year.
- US History using the MC results of the EOC, realign units of instruction and CA to EOC standards. In addition, refine a plan for the research paper based on student results and teacher feedback from last school year.

➤ Principals must have a sign in sheet with location/date/all participants names, if this is done at your school/within the district. This applies even if you allow a small group to work together, i.e. a small group of PE teachers working on curriculum.

- ➤ Principals must have agenda describing the work
- Schools will keep the documentation for the above on file
- ➤ Principals should require the teacher to have a certificate or other documentation if the PD was not conducted at the school/or by the district. This applies if the teacher went to a state (or other) conference.
- ➤ Days # 3 & 4 must be Professional Development, not "work in your room" activity.
- ➤ Principals should plan in advance with their staff how those days will be used.
- ➤ Since all schools indicated a need for "technology training for instructional purposes," I have asked Linda Payne to design some PD for that purpose. Those sessions, with principal approval, could be used for optional PD # 3 & 4 days. Tentatively, those days will be July 11, 12, 16 (repeat of July 11) and 17 (repeat of July 12).
