Restorative Justice & Restorative Practice

<u>Restorative Justice (RJ)</u> is a process being discussed nationally and in the local community as a theory of justice that emphasizes repairing the harm caused by criminal behavior through the <u>legal/court system</u>.

<u>Restorative Practices (RP)</u> are efforts to apply those principles to the <u>school</u> setting.

The focus of RJ and RP is placed on: identifying and repairing the harm caused by criminal/behavioral events; restoration for those who have been injured; and successful reintegration of offenders to society as contributing members.

Goal: Review Restorative Justice & Restorative Practice as they relate to implementation in communities and schools.

Strategy: Visit and discuss with other schools/districts implementing Restorative Practices.
