## Estimated Changes from KCCT Proficiency to College and Career Readiness <br> Reading and Mathematics

In August, a statistical study linking EXPLORE to K-PREP tests will be conducted. Without the final study, only rough estimates can be made of possible proficiency rates in the new system. When aligning standards to college readiness expectations, it is anticipated the number of students in the Proficient or higher categories will significantly decrease and be more aligned with the Council on Postsecondary Education's ACT Benchmarks (18 in English, 19 in math and 20 in reading).


Note: Science and social studies data are based on the 2007 Kentucky Core Content for Assessment 4.1; therefore, distributions of proficiency will be similar to the 2011 profile. Once national standards are adopted, science and social studies will be placed on a college readiness scale.
