For all mathematics courses at Pikeville High School or Pikeville Junior High School, nine weeks grades will be represented by two categories, Classwork/Homework and Summative Assessments. Classwork/Homework will count as 30% of each nine weeks grade. Summative Assessments will count as 70% of each nine weeks grade.

All mathematics courses will give a comprehensive exam at the end of each nine weeks. Each nine-week comprehensive exam will ask questions from material taught in the current nine weeks of any previous nine weeks.

For all required classes, 7<sup>th</sup> grade math, 8<sup>th</sup> grade math, Algebra I, Algebra I Honors, Algebra II Honors, Geometry, or honors Geometry, 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks comprehensive exams will count as 20% of the Summative Assessments category. Semester exams will serve as the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> nine weeks comprehensive exams and will count according to school. Policy.

For all other mathematics courses in which semester exams are not required, all four nine weeks comprehensive exams will count as 20% for the Summative Assessments category.
