ACT Benchmarks: English—18, Mathematics—19 and Reading—20-Must meet all three benchmarks

COMPASS Test: English—74, Mathematics—36 and Reading—85

KYOTE: College Readiness Mathematics—22

Students are college ready if they meet all three ACT benchmarks or if they missed one or more of the ACT benchmarks, but achieved the college-ready criteria by meeting benchmarks with COMPASS or KYOTE.

ASVAB: Meets score of 55

ACT Work Keys-Obtains Silver Certificate

KOSSA-Meets score of Multiple Choice-70 and Constructed Response/Performance Based-75

Industry Certificates-Obtains an industry certificate that is based on Industry Standards
