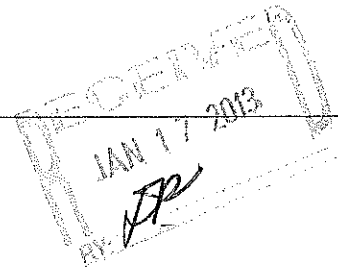

Ms. Perkins,

Per our earlier discussion on improving security I am recommending that we purchase and install the panic buttons and monitoring services shown on the attached quote.

Essentially this package, in each location listed below, would give us the following:  
-3 wireless panic buttons to be mounted in a "primary", "secondary" and "back-up" work station.

-A panic button alert would go directly to dial one's dispatch who would then alert 911 immediately for police response (no "call back" for validity, police would come).

The cost: In order to not sign a lengthy contract the equipment expense up front is a little more expensive (this is a 1 year agreement). The package would include the necessary Honeywell panel and 3 wireless panic buttons. There would also be the monthly monitoring fee.

Equipment & Install	\$495
Monthly monitoring fee	\$33.95
Email and text alert from alarm drop	\$7 month additional

Initial set up cost for all six facilities listed below \$2,970

Recurring monitoring costs PER BUILDING (including email and text alert) \$491.40 (\$2,948.40 Total, all schools). First year total cost of equipment and monitoring \$5,918.40.
