1. OUTSTANDING ISSUES

- a) Construction Schedule Pencil Copy
 - i) RTA to confirm all review comments have been received and transmit them to Endeavor.
 - ii) Endeavor to distribute final schedule as soon as possible.

2. CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS (Schedule)

- a) Review current status of work.
 - i) Storm line installation near tennis courts is ongoing.
 - ii) Building Pad
 - a) Most recent proof roll was successful
 - b) Soil to be tested by testing agent again Wednesday morning, pending weather.
 - iii) Geothermal well drilling is ongoing. 8 remain.
 - iv) Aggregate piers could start as early as the end of the week, pending the weather.
- b) Delivery dates.
 - i) No major deliveries expected soon.
- c) Possible delays.
 - i) Further modifications to DS-6 due to unexpected underground route of gym roof drain.
 - a) New route and connection approved by RFI #15
 - b) Proposal Request and Pricing from Endeavor and RTA to be issued as soon as possible. (post-meeting update: PR #06 issued and pricing received 3/5/13)

- c) Resulting Change Order #06 is to be completed and delivered to owner for next Board Meeting. (post-meeting update: CO #06 was issued for owner review late 3/5/13)
- d) This work affects the timing of the removal of existing drain structure in the building pad, which has been partially removed. Method for abandoning remainder of structure in place to be reviewed with RTA as needed, if structure is not removed completely.
- ii) Saturday work will be pursued if required.
- iii) Softball Press Box completion date of April 15 was reviewed.
 - a) Lenny proposed delaying construction until after softball season, stating that summer months would be free from field use.
 - (1) The possibility of installing aggregate piers and concrete pad only before the softball season and completing the press box after the season was also discussed.
 - b) David stated all related submittals have been made and April 15 may still be attainable under ideal conditions.
 - c) It was agreed that Endeavor would proceed with Softball Press Box construction as planned and protect the site as needed from any ball game related activities that may occur.

 - vi) Owner requested new PR to relocate existing irrigation hydrant from north end of football field to south end of field and add required underground piping from baseball press box supply line.

11. ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- a) Football Press Box and Bleacher coordination
 - i) Ken stated he had been in brief contact with Toadvine Industries and that further coordination is required for the Football Press Box and top of Bleachers. He will pursue more coordination with Toadvine as needed. RTA to assist if needed.
- b) Existing sanitary exposed for tie in on west side of football field
 - i) Piping has been observed by the contractor as having reverse slope and bellied in some areas. It was stated that the overall run has proper direction of flow. No gravel bed under the piping has been observed at this sanitary line. Tim stated there have been minor issues possibly related to this in the past. All parties will continue to monitor this situation. No new action required at this time.

- c) Manhole in existing sanitary line west of football field was found under existing fence, contrary to survey drawings. Fence was removed for access. New fence configuration or new gate may be required. Possible RFI forthcoming.
- d) Construction sign and wall panel mock up location were discussed by Lenny, RTA and Endeavor after the progress meeting. Both are to be located between the softball outfield fence and the parking lot, near the parking lot rear entrance.

 - a) March 21 at 9am.
