District Facilities Plan Hearing Report

A public hearing was held at South Green Elementary on March 11, 2013 at 5:30 pm local time. (CST) The purpose of the hearing was to propose a new District Facilities Plan developed by the Glasgow Independent Schools Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 11-0 in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board voted 4-0 to approve the new plan.

To participate in the hearing, there were (0) people in attendance, excluding Randy Wilkinson, hearing officer. Randy Wilkinson, DPP-Facilities Director, served as the locally-appointed hearing officer. Those present included Superintendent Sean Howard, Attorney Tom Davis, Board Members, Elaine Richardson, Leigh Lessenberry, Amelia Kiser, Wade Stone, and Barret Lessenberry. Also present were Scott Jones, Shelly Smith, Jan Dickinson, Keith Hale and Chad Muhlenkamp.

Comments

Randy Wilkinson called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. It was explained that those people wishing to speak would be given the opportunity and that written statements would be accepted. All considerations will be made available to the Kentucky Board of Education via the hearing officer's report. The hearing officer read the proposed new District Facility Plan which included:

Happy Valley Major renovations, including abatement, security entrances-communication, replacement of HVAC, plumbing, electric systems, and roof replacement. Also, new fire protection, and new technology wiring to meet KETS standards.

South Green, Major renovations to include roof replacement, HVAC, upgrades, new door and hardware ADA Compliant, fire protection (including sprinkler system), technology wiring to meet KETS standards and installation of a telephone intercom security system along with a new security entrance vestibule.

Glasgow Middle—Major renovation including roof replacement, development of security entrance vestibule, HVAC controls, replacement, new plumbing fixtures, upgrade of technology to meet KETS standards and installation of a telephone intercom security communications system.

Glasgow High School –Highland connection of the telephone intercom security communication

Central Office -- Major Renovation to include site development parking lot lighting, new HVAC, ADDA accessibility, fire protection, roof replacement, new kitchen equipment.

District Needs

Glasgow High- New Athletic Fields, High School Bleachers

South Green Elementary—storm drainage and paving, site lighting and entrance canopy

Glasgow Middle major renovation to include interior finishes accessories, replace VCT, 500 Seat Exterior Bleachers, Concessions and Restroom and Football Stadium Lighting

The floor was opened to those who wished to make a statement or have their statement read, but no interest was shown by anyone to make any communication known.

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan developed by the Glasgow Independent School District Planning Committee and adopted by the Glasgow Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Glasgow Independent School District. A copy of the new plan is attached.
