Ladies and Gentlemen,

I hope this email finds you all well. I'm writing this and including several documents for your review concerning high school baseball in our state. I've been very blessed to have played 4 years of high school baseball and I'm currently in my 15th year as a coach of high school baseball, all in the great state of Kentucky. From 1989 thru 2013 I've seen our high school game progress both as a player and as a coach into something that I'm quite proud to be a part of, and that is a direct reflection of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association. I've had the opportunity to coach against some of our state's greatest coaching legends...Bill Miller, Mac Whitaker, Charlie Adkins and Jody Hamilton just to name a few. These gentlemen have set a very high standard of excellence and have paved the way for a bright future. I know many of these coaches have worked diligently with the KHSAA to ensure the growth of the game of baseball across the Commonwealth.

I realize I'm a very small part of this, but I know from our Coaches Association meetings over the past several years that the majority of our coaches would love for the KHSAA to consider a move to a classification system for the game of baseball. In my spare time over the past several months, I have worked on several documents to present a proposal to the decision makers. I would love to see our game to continue to progress as it has over the past 25 years into the next 25 and I really feel like classifying baseball could take the quality of our game to the next level. Also affording more student athletes from all across our state, regardless of demographics, the opportunity to compete for the grandest prize for these kids...a State Championship.

The attached charts and documents are based on enrollment info I've taken from the KHSAA for 2009-2010. I realize that enrollment numbers change every year and alignments are changing with consolidation. This could perhaps just be a starting point. I've also done the best I could do with what I know about the geography of some of our member schools...again these documents are just a place to start and work with. Attached you will find a 4 class system (based on 09-10 enrollment numbers) and a proposed playoff format. I know that some obstacles keeping this from happening might be travel issues/concerns, but for the most part it's possible to keep the regions similar to distances traveled now in regions. The districts are a little more spread out, but with creative scheduling individual member schools could keep their travel schedule comparable to what it is now.

Again, it's humbling just to have the opportunity to coach the young men in the game that I love and I consider myself to be the least of any of my peers. I'm not sure what the process is to get something this large scale done, but I'd love to hear back from each of you and see what your thoughts and concerns might be. I believe in high school athletics to be a major part in the educational experience for our children and I appreciate everything that the KHSAA has done and will continue to do to ensure the growth of all athletics.
