Postseason- \$5 additional is added to the base fee if the assignment location is not in the normal service area (local association) of the official.</p> <p>All Sports - Postseason - Mileage allowance for KHSAA postseason competition at press time is \$.35 per mile.</p> <p>Board of Control Standard Fee Review Schedule - The Board will routinely review fees in all sports on a defined schedule in the fall of the year prior to implementation of any change. In the interim, changes will only be considered if there is a change in playing rules or number of officials that necessitates emergency review. Effective 2004/05 (and every four years thereafter) – Football and Soccer; Effective 2005/06 (and every four years thereafter) – Volleyball, Cross Country, Track and Swimming; Effective 2006/07 (and every four years thereafter) – Basketball and Wrestling; Effective 2007/08 (and every four years thereafter) – Baseball and Softball</p>
