Superintendent's Report

TELL Survey

- The **T**eaching, **E**mpowering, **L**eading and **L**earning (**TELL**) **Kentucky** survey is an anonymous statewide survey of licensed school-based educators to assess teaching conditions at the school, district, and state level.
- 5,646 JCPS Educators participated in the TELL Survey this March. Our response rate was 80.9%.
- 66 school sites had response rates of 100%.
