6 RELATES TO: KRS 156.070, 156.160, 158.6451, 160.290

7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.070, 156.160

8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 156.160 requires the Kentucky Board
9 of Education to establish courses of study for the different grades and kinds of common schools,
10 with the courses of study to comply with the expected outcomes for students and schools
11 established in KRS 158.6451. KRS 156.070(1) requires the Kentucky Board of Education to
12 manage and control the common schools and all programs operated in the schools. KRS 160.290
13 authorizes local boards of education to provide for courses and other services for students
14 consistent with the administrative regulations of the Kentucky Board of Education. This
15 administrative regulation incorporates by reference the Kentucky core academic standards,
16 which contains the general courses for use in Kentucky's common schools.

17 Section 1. Before graduating from a Kentucky public high school, a student shall meet the
18 minimum content requirements established in the Kentucky core academic standards.

19 Section 2. Incorporation by Reference. (1) The "Kentucky Core Academic Standards, June, 2013
