Sherman Carter Barnhart (SCB) will be present at the board meeting on Thursday, May 16, 2013, at which time we will report on the status of Hardin County school projects nearing project closeout. Information regarding progress on North Hardin High School, Vine Grove Elementary, and Hardin County Early College & Career Center (ECCC) is also included here for your information.

Renovation to Radcliff Elementary – Phase 3

SCB met with Morel Construction on April 17, 2013, to review the moisture results from CDI. SCB will be scheduling a meeting with Morel and Hardin County Schools to develop a schedule for remediation. Most likely, this work will need to occur after the end of the school year, over the summer or fall break.

North Middle School

Alliance has provided verification that all applicable roof warranties are in place. SCB has recommended final payment.

North Hardin High School – Phase 2

SCB and Shrout Tate Wilson met with Hardin County Schools administration at the central office on May 1, 2013, to review the project.

SCB will be seeking Construction Document approval at the June board meeting.

Vine Grove Elementary Site Improvements

SCB has submitted Schematic Design documents, the BG-2 and BG-3, and construction documents to the Kentucky Department of Education for review and approval. Upon notification of approval, SCB will release the project for bidding.


Hardin County Early College & Career Center
