BACKGROUND





Community partnership and strategies were forged in the Greater Louisville Education Commitment (GLEC).

Goal: By 2020, 40% of working-age adults will hold a bachelor's degree; 10% will hold an associate degree.





55,000 Degrees Launched

Goal: Add 40,000 bachelor's degrees, 15,000 associate degrees by 2020

Objectives:

- 1. Create a college-going culture
- 2. Use business community's leverage to accelerate attainment
- 3. Prepare students for success in college, career, life
- Make post-secondary education accessible and affordable
- 5. College persistence, performance and progress



The JCPS pledge

By 2020:

- 90% graduation rate
- 85% of graduates enroll in college
- 40% of GED recipients enroll in college
- 70% of graduates are college/career ready
- 3% annual dropout rate
- 21 average district ACT score
- 6% freshman retention rate
