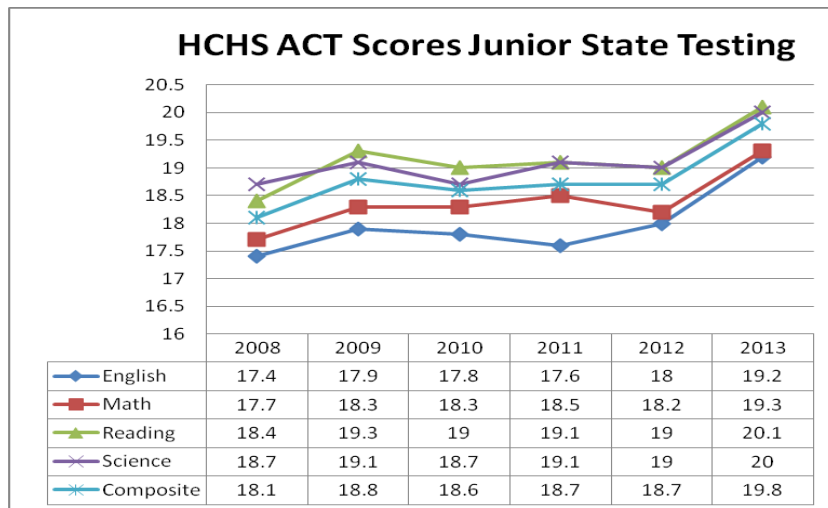


ACT State Testing Report for HCHS Juniors assessed March 2013

All Henderson County High School juniors took the ACT test in March 2013 as part of the Kentucky assessment program. The 2013 scores for HCHS are outlined below. The HCHS class of 2014 recorded ACT scores that are the highest ever on state testing. In addition to showing significant increases, the juniors scored well above the state average in all five areas.

Observations of HCHS juniors' ACT average score data:

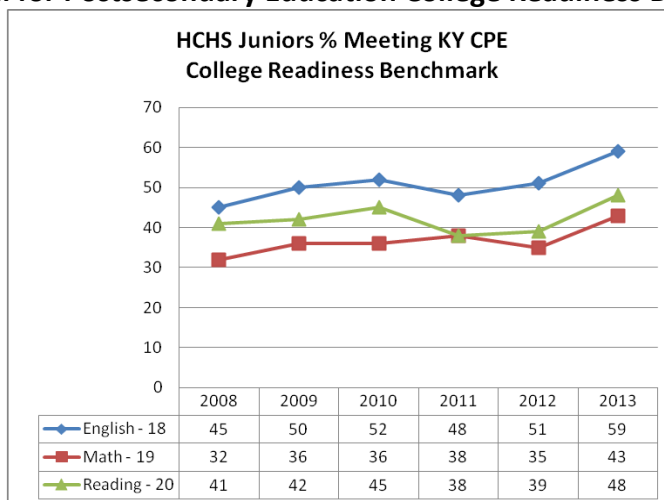
- Highest ACT scores ever on state testing.
- Composite not only topped the 19 mark, it increased 1.1 to an overall composite of 19.8.
- Reading and Science averaged 20 or higher for the first time.
- English and Math both averaged over 19 for the first time since state ACT testing.
- Well above state average in all five areas.
- All content areas and the composite showed significant increases. A 1 point gain on an ACT average constitutes more than a year's growth.
 - English up 1.2 points
 - Math up 1.1 points
 - Reading up 1.1 points
 - Science up 1 point
 - Composite up 1.1 points

The percentage of Henderson County High School juniors meeting the College Readiness Benchmarks for ACT and the Kentucky Council for Postsecondary Education is outlined below. The College Readiness Benchmarks, set by ACT, are the minimum test scores required for students to have a high probability of success in credit bearing college courses. The Kentucky Council for Postsecondary Education has also set statewide benchmarks to indicate college and career readiness.

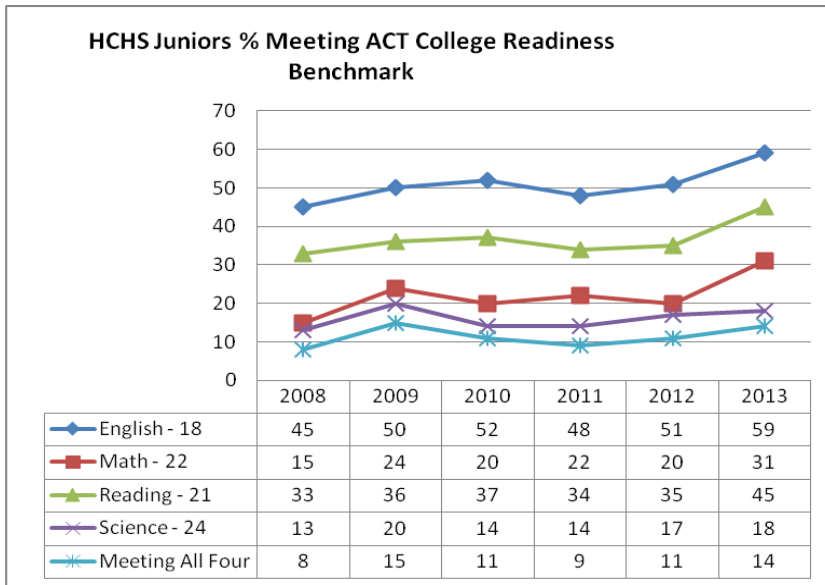

Observations of HCHS juniors percent meeting ACT college readiness benchmark data:

- In English, Reading and Math, the highest ever percentage to meet benchmarks.
- At or above state average in all content areas.
- All areas marked an increase of 2012 scores.
 - English up 8%
 - Math up 11%
 - Reading up 10%
 - Science up 1%
 - All Four up 3%

The data is a testament to the concentrated and dedicated effort of students and staff toward meeting the goal of college and career readiness for all students.

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
