Agreement

This agreement between the Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education (KACTE) and Jefferson County Board of Education (Board), doing business as Jefferson County Public Schools (JCPS), is intended to assist in the annual KACTE Summer Program (Summer Program), a program which provides professional development opportunities to Career and Technical Education staff throughout the state.

The Summer Program provides the most cost-effective, high-quality CTE professional development available each year, in the state or nearby, and for JCPS CTE professionals that involves minimal travel expense and no housing charges. Each year, several hundred JCPS teachers and administrators attend the program. JCPS supports the Summer Program in a number of other ways, including use of facilities when needed and available for workshops and demonstrations.

Section I -Services provided by JCPS

JCPS shall:

Work with KACTE to identify a JCPS employee to perform the services;

Assist KACTE with the coordination and management of the commercial exhibits for Summer Program in Louisville, Kentucky;

Meet with the state Planning Committee and assist with planning for the Summer Program;

Handle the recruiting, contracting, planning and implementation of the Exhibit Hall for the Summer Program.

Section II -Compensation

The Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education (KACTE) will pay JCPS up to \$12,500 to cover the costs of the employees of JCPS for services for the Summer Program occurring within the contract period.

Section III -Period of Agreement

This agreement will begin on September 24, 2013 and terminate on July 31, 2014. This agreement can be terminated by either party upon written notice of not less than thirty (30) days, except either party may terminate the agreement by shorter notice in the event that KACTE is not able to provide adequate funds for the continuance of the program.
