

Strand 1 Recommendation

Externships EP 1.3 Safe, Resourced, Supported, & Equipped Schools

o 2 teams of 3 cross curricular teachers from each school will spend four days during summer 2013 in a local business working on a project that can be brought back to their students

o Working with feeder middle schools and 9th students to make the ILP a meaningful and relevant document

Cohort Scheduling EP 2.3 Safe, Resourced, Supported, & Equipped Schools

o School leaders institute and protect a cohort scheduling method to increase the instructional time for teachers and students in a designated academy

Evaluation of academy effectiveness and student success EP 2.4 Resourced, Supported, & Equipped Schools
