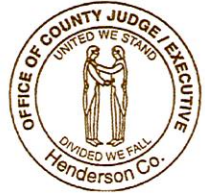

"RECOGNITION OF HENDERSON COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM FOR KENTUCKY PERFORMANCE RATING FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRESS (K-PREP) TESTING SCORES"

the Henderson County School System is dedicated to ensuring that all Henderson students are provided a high-quality education that prepares them for success in college and career; and

the Unbridled Learning: College/Career Readiness for All program includes multiple measures that take into account all areas of a school's work and is designed to promote continuous improvement in our schools; and

Whereas

the Kentucky-Performance Rating for Educational Progress (K-PREP) assessment exams were administered to students in grades three through twelve; and

Whereas

the Henderson County School System showed tremendous district wide improvement on the latest state testing results. In 2012, Henderson County Schools were in the 50th percentile of all school districts in the state. A five point increase in the overall 2013 score elevated the district to the 83rd percentile placing the district among the top twenty percent in the state.
