Thank you for considering our request. Attached is a sample itinerary for you to view.

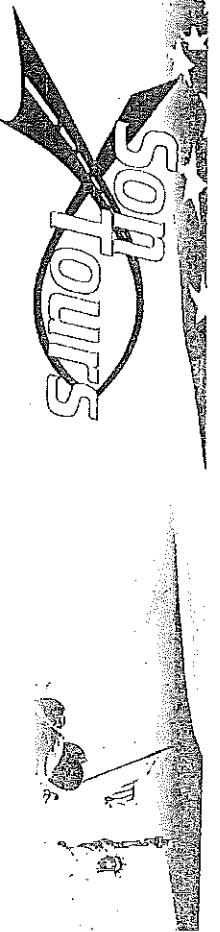

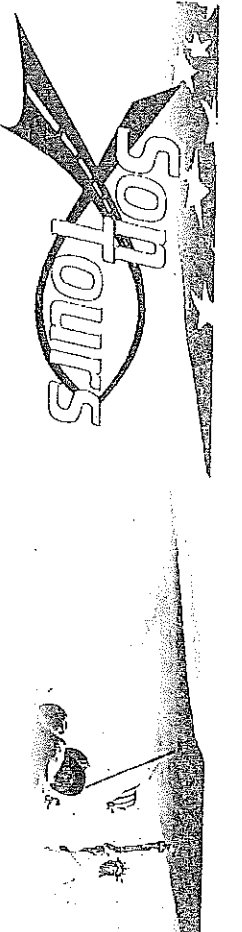

Event Description:

The UK Male Chorus Day takes place on the campus of the University of Kentucky in the School of Music and in the Singletary Center for the Arts. The participants spend one full day in combined rehearsals on advanced high school choral repertoire designed for the male singer. Part of the training includes workshops by the vocal faculty members at UK, tailored to the unique challenges of the developing male voice. On Saturday afternoon, the students from Kentucky, Tennessee, and Indiana will present a mass performance with approximately 200 performers, followed by concerts by the UK Men's Choir and the male a cappella group, the acoUstiKats.

Trip Purpose:

This is a trip for selected male students who show gifted characteristics with their vocal and musical abilities. In tying with the PLCS Program Review, these students will also receive a miniature tour of the UK School of Music, as well as have the opportunity to speak to admissions personnel about the steps that they can take if they are interested in pursuing music performance or music education as a career.
