We are so excited to announce that we will be attending our first field study to Mr. Gatti's (1108Lyndon Lane) on Tuesday, December 10<sup>th</sup>. It will be a great way to incorporate fractions with a real world experience. Students will attend a class to explore fractions and the class finale will have them make their own pizza. During this lesson, the students will learn about fractional parts of a whole. They will learn how to divide and describe equal shares for a whole by using real world connections, PIZZA. Students will compare fractional parts to determine which is larger or smaller. They will learn the different names for the fractional parts. As an extra bonus, a chef will address the group to discuss his career. After the class, they will be able to eat from the pizza and pasta buffet for lunch. They will also have a little time to play video games, with the understanding that they will then have to write about one of their gaming experiences, using sensory details, upon returning to school.

The cost of the field trip will be \$12.00 for the class, lunch, and the bus. Students may bring extra money the day of the trip to use while playing video games. However, please do not send any more than \$5.00 in a Ziploc baggie. Students will be solely responsible for keeping up with their money and choosing how to spend it. Please discuss with them any rules you have for them (games they shouldn't play, if they are allowed to share change with a friend, etc) the night before our trip. If you would like to send in money as a donation for the class to share, please place it in an envelope and mark it 'Donation' so that we can hand it out as needed.

We hope that you will be able to attend this field study with your child IF you have a crime check on file at the Board of Education BEFORE the trip and you are able to drive to Mr. Gatti's (you may find parents to carpool with, at school that day). You will pay at Mr. Gatti's.
