Objective 1: Create and Support a Culture of College-Going and Completion

- The JCPS class of 2013 reached a 77 percent cohort graduation rate
- The college-going rate of JCPS graduates declined from 68% to 61% (2007-2012).

Objective 3: Prepare Students for Success in College, Career, Citizenship and Life

- 51% of JCPS students are college/career ready in 2013, up from 45% in 2012
- The JCPS class of 2013 had an average ACT score of 18.8

Objective 4: Make Postsecondary Education Accessible and Affordable

- JCPS saw its melt rate increase from 11 percent to 19 percent since 2007.
