

2013 JCPS SCHOOL NURSE DATA REVIEW

JCPS School Nurses responded to over 86,000 office visits from students during the 2013 school year, representing a 14.8% increase over the 2012 school year. Approximately 92.2% of student office visits resulted in the student being returned to class last year, compared to 91.7% during the 2012 school year.

The accountability data for the Kentucky Performance Rating for Educational Progress (KPREP) shows that while not statistically significant; schools with nurses outperformed a control group on every major 2013 KPREP accountability measure when compared to the prior year's performance.



Novice readers increased in elementary schools with and without nurses, as was the trend for JCPS elementary schools overall.



Attendance decreased in elementary schools with and without nurses, as was the trend for JCPS elementary schools overall.
