## How Do Students and Parents Access the ILP?

### Students

1. Log on to the Jefferson County Public Schools (JCPS) Web site at **[www.jcpsky.net](http://www.jcpsky.net)**.
2. Click on *Students*, *Logins*, and *JCPS Online*.
3. Enter your username and password. Contact your school if you do not have this information.
4. Click on *Career Cruising*.

### Parents

1. Log on to the JCPS Web site at **[www.jcpsky.net](http://www.jcpsky.net)**.
2. Click on *Parents* and then *Parent Portal*.
3. Click on the green Parent Portal Acceptable Use Policy tab to read and accept the terms.
4. Click on the red See My Student's Career Interests (Career Cruising) tab.
5. Enter your username and password. Contact your child's school if you do not have this information.

## Career Cruising

The ILP is fully integrated with a career exploration and planning tool that students use to explore career and college options and to develop a career plan. Using this tool, students:

- Explore careers (beginning in the sixth grade) that match their skills and interests.
- Research colleges and technical schools.
- Explore military careers.
- Find scholarships.
- Research how to pay for college.
- Take assessments, including Career Matchmaker and the Learning Styles Inventory.

## Employment Guide and Résumé Builder in the ILP

The Employment Guide provides students with valuable advice for all stages of their work search, including developing a job search plan, writing a résumé and cover letter, preparing for that important interview, and the first day on the job. The Employment Guide will lead them step-by-step along the way.

The Résumé Builder is integrated with the ILP to help students format and print professional-looking résumés quickly and easily.
