Objectives of Activity: To allow Bloomfield Elementary and Middle School Beta members the opportunity to interact with and compete against other talented and academically excelled Beta members nationwide. Those in attendance will get to experience Beta at the national level and grow more as individuals and as leaders. Exposure at the national level will also help our students better prepare for the state convention during the 2014-2015 school year.

Pre-trip preparatory activities: Currently we have seven Beta members from BES and forty six members from BMS who have signed up to compete in arts, crafts, talent and academics at the Kentucky Beta Convention on February 19-February 21, 2014. We also have a candidate running for the state office of secretary. We have and will continue to fundraise to help offset the cost of attending the state and national conventions. If we have any student that qualifies at the state level we request permission to travel to support those who will be competing nationally. Those who attend the national convention in 2013 were involved in their individual competitions as well as in our group candidate skit. They were also involved in assisting other candidates from Kentucky. We will coordinate with other schools from the state of Kentucky in regards to travel arrangements and trip activities. The convention is scheduled for June 21-24, 2014. Depending on statewide travel, we may leave or return from the convention a few days prior or post the convention.

Post-trip culminating activities: This event takes place during summer break. Numerous photos and students personal accounts in relation to attending the convention will be collected and put together in a Beta scrapbook. The scrapbook will be available during the beginning of the 2014-2015 school year in an effort to increase parental and student awareness of the National Beta Club and all what it has to offer its members. Any student that wins at the state or national level can count that accomplishment as part of their Governor's Scholars Program application.
