**Objectives of Activity:** To allow Bloomfield Elementary and Middle School Beta members the opportunity to interact with and compete against other talented and academically excelled Beta members nationwide. Those in attendance will get to experience Beta at the national level and grow more as individuals and as leaders. Exposure at the national level will also help our students better prepare for the state convention during the 2014-2015 school year.
