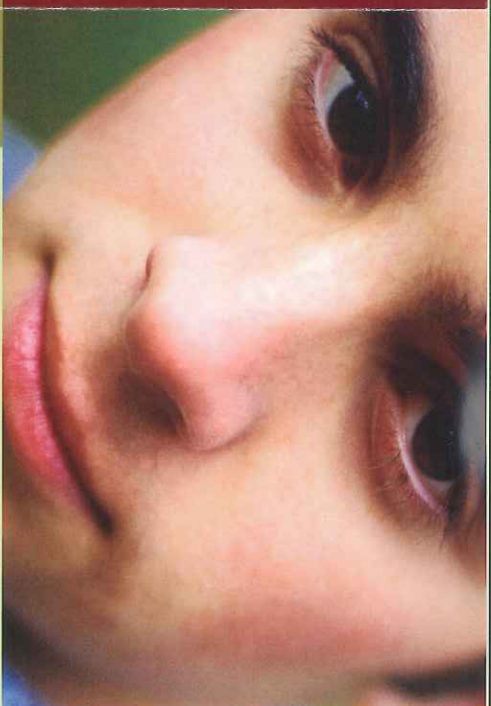
What is CYJS?

CYJS is the Henderson County Center for Youth Justice and Services and is a collaborative program between the Henderson County School System, the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice, the Henderson County Attorney's Office, the Henderson County Police Department, and Lighthouse Counseling Services. The center is located at Henderson County High school. The mission of the center is to serve as a resource for youth in need of services.



What is the goal of CYJS?

The goal of the center is to be a resource and provide services for youth that have behavioral, family, and school related problems. CYJS is committed to reducing the number of youth that are referred to the court system and sent to detention facilities for minor offenses by providing prevention and intervention services.



What are the criteria for a referral to CYJS?

Youth may be referred when exhibiting:

1. Defiant behavior
(Beyond control of school)
2. Behavior problems
3. Aggressive tendencies
4. Mental Health concerns
5. Substance abuse concerns
6. Family Concerns

What is the process after a referral is made?

1. An assessment will be completed to determine what level of services a youth may need.
2. Recommendations regarding services for youth will be determined.
3. Case management will be provided to the youth referred to the center.
4. A treatment plan will be developed for each youth that is assessed.
5. Case status of each youth will be reviewed and progress will be discussed with appropriate parties.
6. Case conferences with the youth and family will occur as needed.
7. Data input and data sharing.

Who can make a referral to CYJS?

Assistant Principal, School Resource Officer,
Director of Pupil Personnel, School Administrators,
the County Attorney, and court personnel.

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
