Sherman Carter Barnhart (SCB) will be present at the board meeting on Thursday, February 20, 2014, at which time we will report on the construction progress at Hardin County Schools Early College and Career Center, projects currently in design and production, and status of Hardin County school projects nearing project closeout.

Hardin County Schools Early College and Career Center

SCB has provided a construction update packet to the board of education documenting construction progress. SCB will be present at the board meeting to discuss the construction progress.

SCB has also forwarded Change Order No. 2 to Hardin County Schools for consideration at the February board meeting. The change order includes a credit for unused geothermal well casing, credit for revisions to the Media Arts Suite, and an add for termite pre-treatment below slab on grade.

North Hardin High School – Phase 7

SCB is currently updating the plans and exterior elevation concepts based on the discussions at the January noon board meeting. SCB will be prepared to present the updated design based on those discussions.

Limited Scope Projects

Construction on the kitchen improvements at Bluegrass Middle School was completed over winter break. SCB has forwarded 2 change orders (1 for each package) for consideration at the February board meeting.

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Page Two SCB is currently awaiting KDE approval of the Meadowview Elementary BG-1 before final subsequent submittal approvals.

The Vine Grove Elementary Phase II Site and Civil Improvements package is presently out to bid. Seven bidders are holding plans. Bids will be received on February 13, 2014.

Projects Nearing Closeout

SCB has met with Mr. Milby and Mr. Taylor regarding recommendations for replacing the tile at Radcliff Elementary. SCB will be conducting a walkthrough at the school to develop a comprehensive review of the tile.
