

Intervention Models: Key Differences

Turnaround/Re-staffing (14 schools)

- ▶ Replace at least 50 percent of the staff. Staff hired as part of broader reform effort may be included in the replacement numbers
- ▶ Provide social emotional and community-oriented services for students

Transformation (4 schools)

- Use evaluations that include student growth as an evaluation component
- Implement strategies to recruit, place, and retain effective staff
- Identify and reward school staff who improve student achievement and identify and remove those who do not
- Provide mechanisms for family and community engagement

Conduct periodic reviews to ensure curriculum is implemented with fidelity	X	X

Provide additional supports and PD to support students with disabilities and LEP students	X	X
Use technology based supports and interventions	X	X
In secondary schools: Offer opportunities to enroll in advanced coursework Improve student transition from middle to high (freshman academies); increase graduation rates; establish early-warning system to identify at-risk students	X	X
