


Attached is PFGW Mod. #37.1 and 37.2 showing modifications to the Main Entry Sidewalk.

Mod 37.1 - reduces the width of the new sidewalk to miss the existing fire hydrant, reduces the ramp width from 5' to 4'-0" and indicates the installation 2'x4' ADA Detectable Warning Surface to the concrete ramp.

Mod 37.2 - modifies the Main Entry Sidewalk near First Street by adding a handicapped ramp with 2'x4' ADA Detectable Warning Surface and deleting the radius and straighting the sidewalk to align with the building end facade as shown on the Mod. Drawing.
