Program Evaluation - Definition

- ◎ **Program evaluation** is a systematic method for collecting, analyzing, and using information to answer questions about projects, policies and programs, particularly about their effectiveness and efficiency

Program Evaluation Work Plan

- Evaluation work plan developed each year based on:
 - > Initiatives in district strategic plan (meetings with chiefs to establish focus areas)
 - > Requests from program directors
 - > Requests from finance department
 - > Grant requirements
 - > Community partnerships

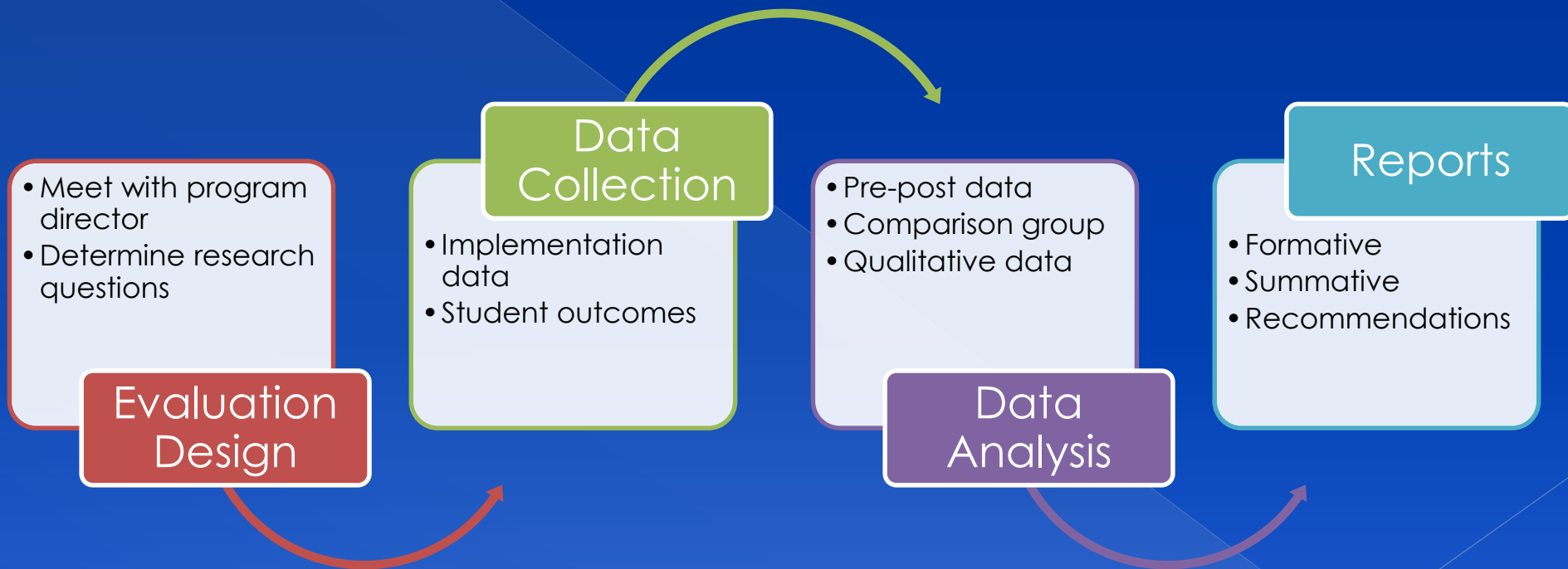

Evaluation Process



Timeline: 2013-14 Evaluations

1. Develop work plan: June – August 2013
2. Data Collection: August 2013 – May 2014
3. Data Analysis and Reporting:
 - Formative data: Oct 2013 – May 2014
 - Summative data: October 2014

Data Types and Analysis

● Implementation Data

- > Observations/Walk-throughs
- > Surveys (Administrators, Teachers, Students, Parents)
- > Focus Groups

● Student Outcome Data

- > Non-academic: suspensions, attendance, referrals, withdraws
- > Formative academic: district benchmark assessments
- > Summative academic: state accountability measures (proficiency rates, college/career ready, graduation)

Logic Model – Assistant Principal

Need

Increasing Elementary student academic and emotional needs

Increasing demands on Elementary Principal as school manager and instructional leader

Input/Activities

Assistant Principals

(all Elementary schools with 400+ students)

Assisting Principals with:

- building operations
- Teacher evaluations
- Teacher professional development
- Student behavior intervention

Allowing Counselors more time to focus on emotional, social & academic student needs

Outputs

- Increased teacher support
- Increased classroom instructional engagement
- Increased academic, social and emotional support for students

Outcomes

Increased student academic achievement

Decreased classroom disruption


Increased student attendance

Reports

- Ad-hoc reports based on requests
- Formative reports provided periodically on implementation data and benchmark assessments
 - > Include recommendations for program improvement
- Summative reports provided based on student outcome data on state accountability measures
- Reports used in budget decisions
