Dear Members of the School Board, HCHS SBDM, and Dr. Sugg,

My name is Laura Freeman and I am the sponsor of the Henderson County High School Leo Club. I am writing today to ask for permission to host a fundraiser. Our planned fundraisers were not successful. Last year, we had planned for two fundraisers to occur during the 2013-14 school year. Our first was to happen around Christmastime, as we were going to partner up with an FRC that had a "Breakfast with Santa" and take and sell photos. We planned this, not knowing for sure if any of the elementary schools/PTAs had this type of activity. This activity did not happen, as no elementary schools or PTAs in the district have a "Breakfast with Santa." Our second fundraiser, "All Wrapped Up in You," is a Valentine's Day fundraiser that did not prove to be very successful. The main reason for this was the amount of snow days the week of February 3rd through the 7th, as these were the days we had planned our sale.

As you know, one of the missions of the Lions Club is to prevent blindness. We are asking permission to host a Candy Day in the community. The purpose of the Candy Day is to raise funds for our club and the Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation. We would like to hold this fundraiser on Saturday, March 29, 2014 from 9 am to 5 pm at Rural King and Walmart. Both businesses have already given their approval. The candy that would be given away would be purchased through our Leo account and also possibly through our sponsoring Lions club. Please see the attached information from Lions Club International regarding the mission of Candy Days.

We intend to use the funds raised to help offset the costs involved with attending the state Lions convention in May, as well as the Leo Conference at the end of May/beginning of June. From this point forward, the Leo Club plans to host 2 Candy Days during the school year, one in fall and one in spring, as we feel these are at the heart of what the Lions and Leo Clubs stand for.

Candy Day Guidelines 2013-2014



During the 2013 - 2014 year in MD 43 Kentucky, dream and take action to Follow Your Dream that...

Seventy five (75) Lions Clubs or more in MD 43 participate in Candy Days.

Candy Day donations to the Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation will equal or exceed \$20,000.

District Candy Day Chairpersons will promote and encourage clubs to participate in Candy Days. The PDG Association does not physically handle candy nor does the MD 43 Candy Day Chairperson order candy for clubs.

Candy Day Chairpersons will provide information to clubs in regard to purchasing candy. Club contributions [check] should be made payable to: Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation (KLEF) and sent to Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation (KLEF), 301 E. Muhammad Ali Blvd, Louisville, Kentucky 40202.

If District Candy Day Chairperson receives check; mail check to KLEF and send report to his/her District Governor.

If District Governor receives check; mail check to KLEF and send report to his/her Candy Day Chairperson.

If Treasurer receives check; mail check to KLEF and send report to his/her Candy Day Chairperson.

If KLEF receives check, KLEF posts contribution and includes in the end-of-the-month report. KLEF keeps record and shares information at any time as to which clubs have contributed and the amount contributed.

KLEF sends end-of-the-month report of Candy Day contributions to MD Candy Day Chairperson. MD 43 Candy Day Chairperson shall send District Candy Day Chairpersons, Council Chairman and District Governors end-of-the-month reports showing contributions. Only donations received by KLEF will be shown in end-of-the-month reports.

District Candy Day Chairperson maintains records of contributions and shares information at any time as to which clubs in their district have contributed and the amount contributed.

Designate September as Candy Day Month; the second weekend (after Labor Day) as Candy Day Weekend; although it is understood that clubs may conduct Candy Days at any time that they may desire.

All participants understand that ½ of Candy Day contributions collected go to KLEF and the other ½ remains in the club.

KENTUCKY LIONS EYE FOUNDATION CANDY DAY OPERATIONAL PLAN

BACKGROUND

Candy Day is a Multiple District 43 project by the Lions Clubs of Kentucky. The Past District Governors Association started the project in 1970. The project is fairly simple. Lions Clubs choose various locations such as shopping centers, grocery stores, roadblocks, etc. and club members give away candy, in return they accept donations. Half of the proceeds go to the Lions Club's charity account and half is sent to the Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation.

GOALS

The goal of the Candy Day Multiple District (State) Chairperson is to develop cooperation between the Governors, Past District Governors Association, Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation and District Chairpersons. The MD Chairperson also provides motivation, promotional materials and candy and/or a source for purchase of candy to the District Chairpersons.

The goals of the District Candy Day Chairperson are to develop cooperation between the Multiple District Chairperson, Past District Governors Association, Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation, District Governor and Lions Clubs of the District.

OBJECTIVES

The Multiple District and the District Chairperson(s) objectives for each year are to increase the participation from the clubs.

MULTIPLE DISTRICT CHAIRPERSON

The MD Chairperson is appointed by the Past District Governors Association and is for a term of three (3) years.

DISTRICT CHAIRPERSON(S)

The respective Governor of each District appoints the District Chairperson. Normal procedure is to ask the Past District Governor (the 2nd year out of his/her governorship) to serve in this position.
