Currently in District 1 (5A) of the 5 teams, 3 of the teams are 1 to 2 hrs travel from Ohio County (Hopkinsville, Christian County and Graves County). The 6A proposed listing has Daviess County, Henderson County, Muhlenberg County and McCracken County in the western part of the state. Ohio County currently plays Daviess County and Muhlenberg County each year. In the proposed grouping Henderson County would be less than an hour away. That would be only McCracken County for a "road trip". Travel time and expenses would be much less with this alignment. Also, each school's revenues would be enhanced by allowing shorter distance for the parents and fans to travel. With schools facing reduced revenues, anything we can do to enhance gate receipts is a positive thing. Ohio County High School respectfully requests to play up to 6A in the 2015 realignment. CONFIRMED
