MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Inactivation of 3/1 Infantry Brigade Combat Team (IBCT)

1. No later than 15 July 2014, 3/1 IBCT will inactivate in support of the Army's current force reduction. Due to this action, approximately 3,500 Soldiers and their Families will depart the Fort Knox Kentucky area.
2. Currently, 3/1 IBCT Soldiers have 121 dependents, ages 14 – 18 years of age, that reside on Fort Knox Kentucky and are eligible to attend the Fort Knox High School. As of 23 January 2014, over 50 percent of 3/1 IBCT's Soldiers and their Families have assignment instructions to depart Fort Knox Kentucky by 1 July 2014. Of note, approximately 250 additional Soldiers have assignment instructions to depart the local area no later than 1 September 2014, further reducing the number of assigned Soldiers to 1,500.
3. Human Resources Command is working to place the remaining Soldiers on assignment instructions to depart 3/1 IBCT between 1 July 2014 and 15 January 2015.
