1.5 UNUSED MATERIALS

- A. Return unused materials to the manufacturer or supplier for credit to the Owner, after installation has been completed and accepted.
 - 1. When requested by the Architect, prepare unused material for storage by Owner where it is not economically practical to return the material for credit. When directed by the Architect, deliver unused material to the Owner's storage space. Otherwise, disposal of unused material is the Contractor's responsibility.

3.1 EXAMINATION

- A. Examine products covered by an allowance promptly upon delivery for damage or defects.

3.2 PREPARATION

- A. Coordinate materials and their installation for each allowance with related materials and installations to ensure that each allowance item is completely integrated and interfaced with related work.

3.3 SCHEDULE OF ALLOWANCES

- A. Allowance No. 1: Include the sum of \$550.00 per thousand for brick. Masonry subcontractors bidding shall include this allowance in their bid. The Owner/Architect will make brick selections. This allowance is not to be utilized for special shapes. Special shapes are to be provided under the base bid with no allowance.
- B. Allowance No. 2: Include the sum of \$15,000.00 for estimated charges by Kentucky Utilities, Alltel and Comcast to provide electrical, telephone and cable TV service.
- C. Allowance No. 3: Include the sum of \$3,000.00 for glass shelving and hardware to the slatwall system specified for the display cabinets in Section 06402.
