Activities, visits and field trips support weekly themes:

Keepin' Cool on Planet Earth (June 9-13) - You've lived on our planet your entire life, but how much do you really know about it? Learn more about Planet Earth and the solar system. We'll even visit a local planetarium! You'll get ot see how recycling works and how Ludlow students can make our schools more "green" so we can be kind to our home planet.

Ludlow Loves the Arts (June 16-20) - Become a Master Artist! There will be plenty of drawing and painting this week of camp to fulfill that creative mind of yours. Study famous artists and their pieces of work. Make your own creations to display and take home. We'll conclude with a scavenger hunt at the beautiful Cincinnati Art Museum!

Take Me Out to the Ballgame (July 7-11) - We'll hit a homerun this week while we study America's favorite pastime! Learn the history of the game of baseball, while we study the rules of the game, sportsmanship, the importance of working together as a team, and how to average baseball statistics and measurements. Attendance Policy

Students must be registered for and attend at least two days per a week. No students will be permitted to attend on dates for which they were not previously registered. If a student fails to attend three or more days for which they were registered, for any other reason other than illness, they will forfeit their space in the Summer Enrichment program. The parent/ guardian will receive a phone call after the second missed session warning that their place will be forfeited.

Behavior Policy

All Summer Enrichment students are expected to follow the rules as outlined in the Ludlow Independent Schools Student Code of Conduct, as well as any other site-specific rules established by the Site Coordinator. The SHINE staff hold the right to suspend students who are in violation of the Student Code of Conduct. In addition, there is zero tolerance for verbal or physical threats to staff or other students.
