Rationale

- In 2014–15, Myers middle school students will be attending other middle schools or Myers at Waggener High School, leaving the current Myers building underutilized.
- Phoenix School of Discovery
 - Phoenix School of Discovery is not able to serve all students who need services throughout the district due to location.
 - Currently, 4th and 5th grade students who would benefit from services at the Phoenix School of Discovery are not able to attend.
- Exceptional Childhood Education (ECE) Units
 - Parents of ECE students currently attending Myers have expressed interest in staying together at Myers
- Early Childhood Consolidation
 - By consolidating numerous early childhood classrooms, we can provide more consistent oversight and also alleviate space concerns in some schools

Proposal

- Relocate the Phoenix School of Discovery to the Myers site and expand the school to serve students in grades 4-12.
- All impacted families who currently attend the Phoenix School of Discovery will be able to apply for a transfer to another school for their student(s).
- Keep three low-incidence ECE units at the Myers site.
- Relocate 12 existing Early Childhood classrooms from other locations to the Myers site.
