**SCOTT COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
DISTRICT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT***

A public hearing was held at the Scott County Central Office on June 30th, 2014, at 5:30 P.m. (local time). The purpose of the public hearing was to propose a new District Facility Plan developed by the Scott County Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 13-0 in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board voted 5-0 to approve the new plan.

There were five individuals in attendance. Those attending were three district employees, one board member and the superintendent.

Hearing Officer Tim Eaton called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. There was no one wishing to speak and no written comments, therefore the hearing officer read the proposed new District Facility Plan which includes; Construction of a new 1,500 student capacity high school, a new 600 student capacity middle school, and two new 600 student capacity elementary schools. It includes major renovations at the Ninth Grade Center, Georgetown Middle School, and Scott County Middle School. Also major renovations at Eastern Elementary, Garth Elementary, Northern Elementary, Western Elementary and Scott County High School are listed. It calls for additions and renovations at Scott County Preschool. This plan includes a district white board initiative as well as several management support areas to be addressed. In the area of management support it calls for construction of a central office, central storage, central vehicle/equipment storage facility, central technology data/network center and a fire-proof central records storage facility. The plan lists discretionary projects to include additions at the Scott Co. High School Farm, several athletic additions and parking lot expansions.

Again, there were no comments or written statements.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan developed by the Scott County Local Planning Committee and adopted by the Scott Board Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Scott County School District. A copy of the new plan is attached.
