- Walk-throughs conducted
 - 498 Classrooms Visited
 - Median Classrooms per School = 40
 - Range was 19 to 81 Classrooms per School
 - Observations Occurred October 2013-April 2014

Teacher Use of Technology

Cell Phones (n = 3)	0%	1%
Computer (n = 269)	51%	54%
Tablet (n = 9)	2%	2%
Not Using Network Accessible Devices		
(n = 53)	13%	10%
None Observed (n = 164)	34%	33%

Student Use of Technology

Cell Phones (n = 36)	4%	7%
Computers (n = 28)	5%	6%
Tablet (n = 10)	2%	2%
Not Using Network Accessible		
Device (n = 103)	25%	20%
None Observed (n = 321)	64%	65%

- Approximately 4% of participating teachers attended districtwide PD
 - School-based PD provided as an alternative
- O Decrease in teacher support (-13%) from fall (56%) to spring (43%)
- Most students (92%) expressed that cell phones can support their learning
- Overall belief that cell phone waiver positively reduced referrals from fall (27%) to spring (32%)

Future Actions/Recommendations

- Principals and Staff will recommit to professional learning to support the waiver
- Principals suggested identifying a smaller subset of interested teachers that participate in the pilot

Future Actions/Recommendations

- Assign Computer Education Support Staff Lead to work and follow-up specifically with identified team at each school (principal suggestion)
- For future waivers, ask schools to complete PD first. After PD has been completed, then approve the waiver.

Requests

We are requesting an extension of the telecommunications waiver for nine of the schools currently participating in the pilot program for the 2014-15 school year.

We are also requesting an approval of the telecommunications waiver for Brown High School for the 2014-15 school year.
