




CHART 3: Are our students achieving similarly across gender groups?

Programs/Strategies to Improve GAP Differences:

- Inclusion of Career Choices class for all students. This will allow for inclusion and documentation of Program Review requirements (23% of state assessment total).
- MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) testing has been implemented for this school year.
- Inclusion of RTI (Response to Intervention) classes for all students not meeting benchmark on MAP assessments (Reading/Math). PBL classes are offered to those students at or above grade level as determined by MAP.
- High school credit courses in Algebra, Integrated Science, World Civilization, and Computer Science are offered to eighth grade students this year in conjunction with required eighth grade courses.
- Gear-Up is implementing the ILP (Individual Learning Plan) process with all students on a rotating basis through Language Arts Classes.
- Teachers are in the process of conferencing with students on recent MAP test scores.
- Implementation of Study Island, ALEKS math, WIN program, Pearson Digits Math, and Reading Plus.
- Continued use of 120 Microsoft Surface RT tablets for eighth grade students with the assistance of Gear-Up and district funding.
- Continued use of thirty iPads with seventh grade science classes.
- Implementation of Canvas.
- PETLL visits are scheduled and will allow for focus on learning and school goals.
- Increased implementation of student centered and project based learning.
- Continued focus on mentoring for all students. (CFES School of Distinction)
- Explore is given at the sixth and seventh grade levels to familiarize students with ACT style testing and identify key areas for growth.
- The Breathitt County Accelerated Academy was established this year to promote and honor student excellence. These students will soon receive Lenovo Yoga 2 lap tops to continue their education and promote flipped classroom experiences.
