6 RELATES TO: KRS 156.070, 156.160, 158.6451, 158.6453, 160.290

7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.070, 156.160, 158.6453

8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 156.160 requires the Kentucky Board  
9 of Education to establish courses of study for the different grades and kinds of common schools,  
10 with the courses of study to comply with the expected outcomes for students and schools  
11 established in KRS 158.6451. KRS 158.6453 requires the revision of academic content  
12 standards. KRS 156.070(1) requires the Kentucky Board of Education to manage and control the  
13 common schools and all programs operated in the schools. KRS 160.290 authorizes local boards  
14 of education to provide for courses and other services for students consistent with the  
15 administrative regulations of the Kentucky Board of Education. This administrative regulation  
16 incorporates by reference the Kentucky [~~core~~] academic standards, which contains the general  
17 courses of study and academic content standards for use in Kentucky's common schools.

18 Section 1. Before graduating from a Kentucky public high school, a student shall meet the  
19 minimum content requirements established in the Kentucky [~~Core~~] Academic Standards.

20 Section 2. Incorporation by Reference. (1) The "Kentucky [~~Core~~] Academic Standards",  
21 **January 2014** [~~September 2013~~], is incorporated by reference.

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
