Dear Ms. Johnston:

On September 19, 2014 we received the following documents concerning an easement agreement between the Hardin County Board of Education and the Hardin County Water District #1:

- Copy of the unexecuted Utility Easement Agreement.
- Plat of proposed Sanitary Sewer Easement.
- Electronic notification of Board approval of the proposed Easement.

Please submit the following:

• Letter from Board of Education declaring the property surplus and stating that disposal of the property will not affect the integrity or usefulness of property crucial to the educational needs of the district.

Note that 702 KAR 4:090 requires that the Board of Education must receive fair market value for the easement, which may be in cash, or in-kind services, or combination of the two. Fair market value may be established by an appraisal by a certified general property appraiser. If fair market value received is in the form of in-kind services, the BOE must be able to demonstrate that in-kind services will equal or exceed the fair market value of the easement.
