2014 – 2015 Textbook Plan

The faculty at South Todd Elementary met on Friday, September 12, 2014 to develop our textbook plan.

Analysis of student performance data has revealed concerns with curriculum inconsistencies in the areas of reading and math. Students at STES have experienced a slight decline in these two areas on MAP and K-PREP assessments.

Our plan addresses academic consistency in reading and math by using textbook funds to purchase the following resources:

- Math: - Envision Math from Houghton Mifflin Publishing
- Reading: - Journey's reading series from Houghton Mifflin Publishing
 - Various student books, leveled readers, chapter books, and mentor text.
 - Leveled Literacy Intervention kits from Heinemann.

Textbook funds allotted for the 2014-15 school year is less than the amount needed to purchase a complete series of any area in reading or math. Teacher editions and limited student editions will be purchased to experiment and collaborate with existing materials.

Once student performance data from K-PREP and MAP assessments are analyzed further, priority ranking of the above resources may change to meet the academic needs of our students.
