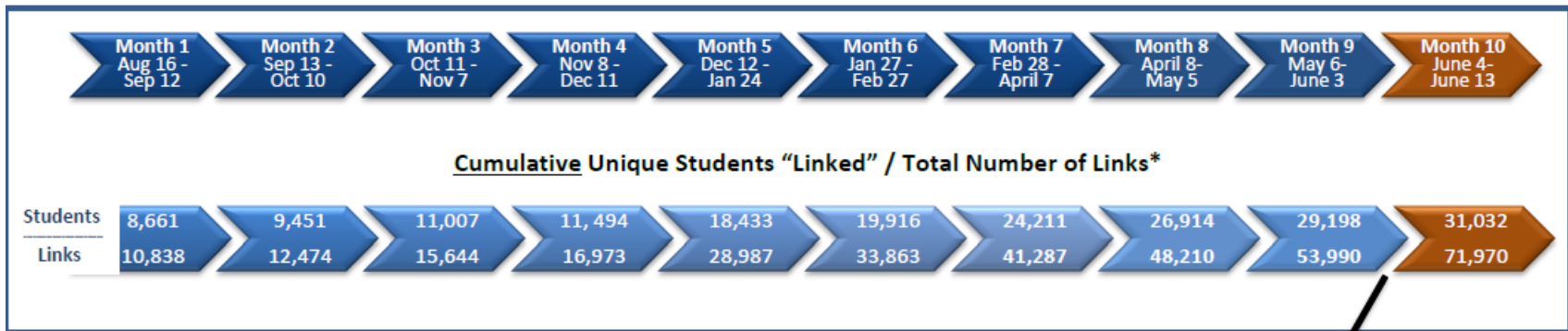

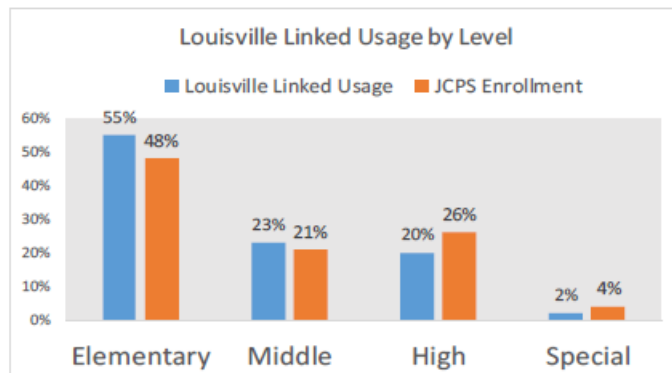
## 2013-14 End of Year Louisville Linked Data Report

### Key Findings:

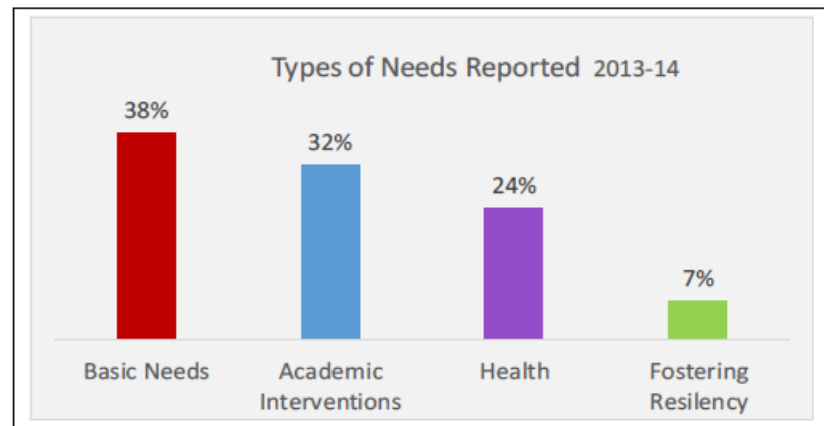
- 31,032 Students have been "linked" to help meet a need.
- These students represent 71,970 needs.
- The highest number of links for any one student was 34.
- 156 students had 10 or more links
- The highest percentage of links are made to address basic needs followed by academic interventions.
- The usage of Louisville Linked is highest in Elementary and overall is proportionate to enrollment at every level.



Large increase due to data entry at end of year



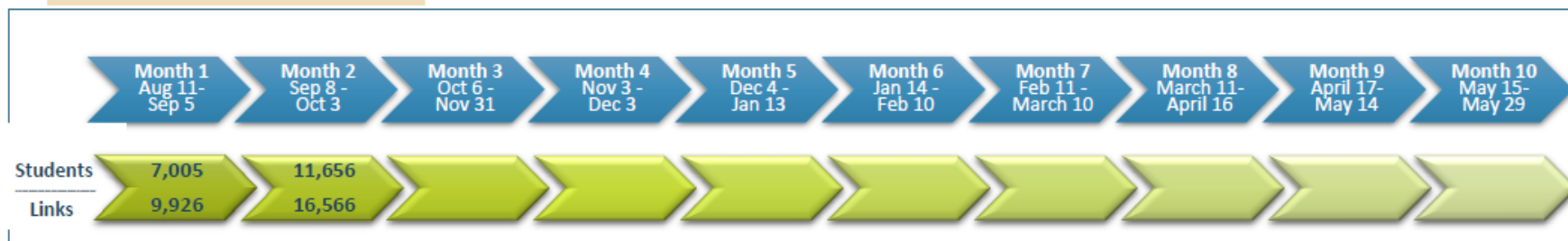

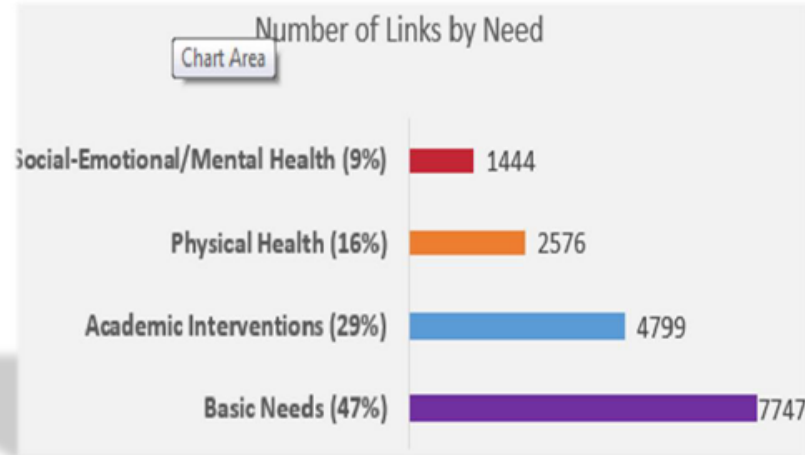
## Key Findings

- **16,566 "links"** were made through the 2<sup>nd</sup> month. An increase of 66% from 1<sup>st</sup> month.
- **145 JCPS schools served**
- **11,656 Students** have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- **2128 students had 2 or more needs linked** with a resource. The highest was 16 links.
