Action Question:

History/Background:

Existing Policy. The Kentucky General Assembly will open its 2015 Regular Session on January 6, 2015. At the October meeting, potential items to be considered for legislative action were reviewed for inclusion in the board's legislative agenda for the next session. The legislative agenda is before the board for final approval in December.

Staff Recommendation(s) and Rationale:
