Briefly discuss need for project (Include baseline data/statistics):

Traditionally, seventh grade students study about past civilizations and far away places. It would be exciting if these students could visit earlier times and experience life as it was! The Bloomfield Middle School students can not take a field trip to the Renaissance but could recreate their own.

Ms. Wheeler, Bloomfield Middle School seventh grade social studies teacher, would like her students to receive more than just a "textbook" glimpse of the past. "This project will give the students an opportunity to experience a world long past."

Goal(s): To recreate a Renaissance Faire at Bloomfield Middle School with costumed characters, music, arts, inventions, demonstrating the lifestyle of the era.

Objective(s):

Students will gain knowledge of and achieve an appreciation of everyday life during the Renaissance. By participating in enrichment activities students will broaden their awareness of the history, architecture, music and sociology of the period.

Estimated number of students to be served by grade level: 142

Describe how this project aligns with content standards:

From the Kentucky Combined Document Program of Studies Students will understand that

- culture is a system of beliefs, knowledge, institutions, customs/traditions, languages and skills shared by a group of people. Through a society's culture, individuals learn the relationships, structures, patterns and processes to be members of the society.
- cultures develop social institutions (e.g., government, economy, education, religion, family) to structure society, influence behavior and respond to human needs.

Students will understand that

- the arts are powerful tools for understanding human experiences both past and present.
- the arts help us understand others' (often very different) ways of thinking, working, and expressing ourselves.
- the arts play a major role in the creation and defining of cultures and building civilizations.

Describe the method for evaluating/measuring the effectiveness of this project and what type of information can be derived from the overall experience (Please list more than one method for evaluation):

Students will be evaluated based on their participation and dress. Students are encouraged to dress in official period costumes, during the Faire activities. A rubric will be developed by teachers and students that will determine the level of involvement.
