APPOINTMENT OF BOARD MEMBER TO SUPERINTENDENT SCREENING COMMITTEE AND APPROVAL OF SUPERINTENDENT SCREENING COMMITTEE **BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:**

On November 6, 2014, Fayette County Schools Superintendent Tom Shelton announced that he would be resigning from his position, effective December 31, 2014.

Under state law, each board of education shall appoint a superintendent of schools after receiving a recommendation from a screening committee. Each board is required to establish the committee at least 90 days before the first date on which the position may be filled.

The law also spells out the composition of the committee, to include two teachers, elected by teachers in the district; one board of education member appointed by the board chairman; one principal, elected by the principals in the district; one parent, elected by the presidents of the parent-teacher organizations of the schools in the district; and one classified employee, elected by the classified employees in the district.

Nominations and elections were held by employees and parents from November 17 through December 15, 2011. The individuals duly elected by their peers are listed below.
