This Resolution made and entered into this <u>13</u> day of January, 2015, by the Ohio County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky;

WHEREAS, the activities of the Ohio County Attorney include the prosecution of cases in Ohio District and Family Courts, the provision of legal representation to Ohio County Government, the traffic safety program, delinquent taxes and the establishment and collection of child support under the provisions of Title IV-D of the United States Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 651, pursuant to the contract with the Cabinet for Family and Children, Commonwealth of Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio County Attorney desires to operate an effective criminal and civil program utilizing the various funding sources available to the office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ohio County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky as follows:

- That the Ohio County Attorney is hereby authorized to retain those funds that
  can be classified as fees, if any, to expend for any lawful purpose in the operation of the
  Ohio County Attorney's office at the discretion of the Ohio County Attorney. Fees shall
  include, but not be limited to, cold checks, delinquent taxes, traffic safety and pre-trial
  diversion, if any.
- That the Ohio County Attorney may expend reimbursements, allocations and/or incentive payments received pursuant to the Title IV-D contract at the County Attorney's discretion for the purpose of the Ohio County Child Support program.
- 3. That fees transferred from the prior County Attorney to the present County Attorney, if any, shall also be permitted to be expended for any lawful purpose in the operation of the Ohio County Attorney's office at the discretion of the present County Attorney.
