REQUEST FOR A SHORTENED SCHOOL DAY

The student also has difficulties with transitions and he has been in a hospital residential setting for several years. All these factors support the shortened school request. This student will attend from 9:05 to 11:05 with a intense transition plan.
- 2. A shortened school day has been requested for this due to anxiety, ADHD, easy frustration level and mood issues. This student will attend from 9:05 to 2:28.
