December 10, 2014

Committee Report

- **Practical Living Department**
 - Michael Martin and Steve Dapper talked about every student having an opportunity to learn about consumerism. PLATO is helping to get students Career ready. We have two more chances to get Career Ready before the end of the year. PLATO is also helping to get students Career ready with additional classes available. We have earned 29 whole credits this year in PLATO.
- **Language Arts Department**
 - Anna Muennich talked about how we are scoring harder on ourselves. We also are doing more writing in every class.
 - Melissa Hawkins talked about keeping a folder on every student. Maybe we can use one drive and keep all writing assignments in one place for each student. Maybe we can get a policy on where to keep the writing for each student, so in the future we know where everything is located.

Old Business

- Mr. Dodd told us one of the SIG Amendments came back and we just need to put in actual numbers and it will be approved.
- Mr. Dodd also reported our enrollment has gone up from last year; we are at about 360 students.
- Teachers have been working on CSIP. Administrators have been writing reports.
- Barb Lund reported on Section One of the AdvancED Report. We need to get better at communication. Maybe we could do an All Call asking for more e-mail addresses. We could also post things on Face Book.
- Bonnie Sizemore will work on Section Two for next month.
- We need to get parents and students involved with the handbook. We then need to have the rules enforced in all classrooms. At this point there is no consistency between the classes.

New Business

PBIS

- Mr. Dodd talked about having a more rigorous curriculum for our higher students.
- Have the committees attach a form to cover what they are covering and send it out with the minutes since we are using more technology.
- Mr. Dodd said he feels scheduling will go better this year since we are filing information better.
- When scheduling, PLATO will provide a variety of extras, but you must be on track to be eligible to take these.
- We are giving more quizzes and tests in classes this year.
- Teachers are going to multiple PD's this year.
- Mission Statement – maybe let the kids help with the development. After the first of the year, try to get businesses and parents involved in helping also.

- We have two major committees: Social/ Culture and Climate, and Leadership.

Mr. Dodd reviewed the School Safety Plan with the Council.

Mr. Dodd wants members to bring their Binders to the next meeting to go over the by-laws.

Bonnie Sizemore made a motion to extend the meeting. Barb Lund seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Needs Assessment

- Hire a Registrar.
- Hire a Reading Teacher.
- PD on Special Education Co-Teaching.
- Want books for Algebra 1.5 and Integrated Social Studies (this can be found on line and teachers can create lesson plans).
- With a new Business Teacher we will need more computers. The Middle School SIG will have \$25,000. (We could move the Middle School Lab to the High School and purchase new computers for Middle School).
- Library needs a new floor (about \$20,000).

We need to set SBDM Meeting dates for next year. The meeting for January will be January 21st (third Wednesday). We will set the rest of the meetings next month.

Linda Griffith made a motion to adjourn. Barb Lund seconded the motion. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:10 pm.
