- DHS continues with benchmark assessments and analysis in an effort to improve student performance on End of Course exams.
- We are very excited to announce that we are partnering with Gateway Technical and Community College to offer a variety of dual credit courses for our juniors and seniors next year. It may be possible for DHS graduates to finish high school with a total of 24 college credits and career ready! By moving in this direction, we will likely be limiting the number of AP courses we offer at the high school. Dual credit courses will likely produce better results.
